



ULTIMATE APPLIANCE FIT GUIDE

1. Measure the "Three Dimensions" of your space

Don't just measure your old appliance—measure the **opening** it sits in.

- **Width:** Measure at the narrowest point (often at the countertop or baseboard).
- **Height:** Measure from the floor to the bottom of the cabinets. Check both the left and right sides, as floors and cabinets aren't always perfectly level!
- **Depth:** Measure from the back wall to the front of your counters.

2. Check the "Breathing Room"

Appliances need a little space to "breathe" and move.

- **Ventilation:** Leave at least **1 inch** of space in the back and on top for proper airflow (especially for refrigerators and dryers).
- **Hinges and Handles:** If your fridge is next to a wall, ensure there is enough clearance for the door to swing open at a **90° angle** so drawers can slide out fully.

3. Map the "Path of Entry"

Your new appliance has to get *into* the house before it can get *into* the kitchen.

- Measure the width of your **front door, hallways, and any tight turns** or stairwells.
- Compare these measurements to the "Width" and "Depth" of the unit you are buying.

4. Know Your Connections

Before you visit us, take a quick peek behind your current units:

- **Electric vs. Gas:** Does your stove or dryer plug into a 240V outlet, or is there a gas line?
- **The Plug Type:** For electric dryers and ranges, take a photo of your outlet. Is it a **3-prong or 4-prong**?
- **Water Lines:** Ensure you have a functioning shut-off valve for refrigerators with ice makers or for your washing machine.

5. The "Pro-Tip" Photo Gallery

Your smartphone is your best shopping assistant! Snap a quick photo of:

1. The space where the new appliance will go.
2. The wall outlets/connections.
3. The model number tag on your old unit (if you liked the way it fit).
